It's Regatta time once again, with preparations for the big day well under way.

The beautiful Pool Meadow will as usual host this great event.

Last year we introduced the Home Produce Tent. This proved to be such a great success that the number of classes has been increased to 42. All the usual stalls, games and side shows will be present too.

New this year will be Vegan cakes and an Asian Food stall, plus all the usual offerings including Frogmore@the bakery, The Tea Tent, Rose Farm Hog Roast and BBQ, South Hams Brewery Beer Tent, Pimms and Prosecco, and the Ice Cream Van.

The ever popular Banned From The Moor will play throughout the afternoon supported by The Plymouth Morris Men, a Zumba display, and new this year, a Belly Dancer.

The afternoon will start with the Mud race, followed by the Rowing races, Raft race and Paddleboard races. These will all take place when the tide is at a suitable height.

Attractions will include the Dog Show, Family Sports, Tug O War, Donkey Rides, The Ferret Rescue Centre, Swing Boats, Bouncy Castle, plus many other children's games.

Please come along for a coffee and a chat and a piece of Eileen's delicious cakes! All ages welcome.

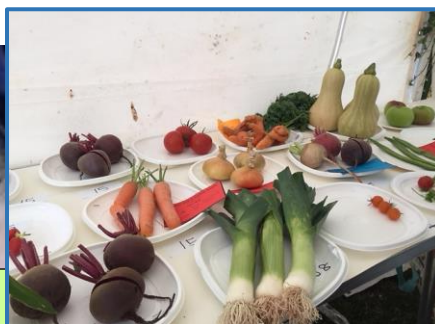

SHOW CLASSES

FOOD: Coffee & Walnut Cake, Chocolate Brownies, Savoury Scones, Quiche, Hummus, Gingerbread Man, Cheese Straws, Rock Cakes, Jam, Marmalade, Chutney and a Fruit Spirit

CRAFT: A wall hanging, painting, limerick or poem, painted pebble, vegetable person and photo of family member.

FLORAL: Basket/trug arrangement, flowers in a tea cup, posy in repurposed container and wildlife garden in a tray.

GARDEN: Apples, pears, soft fruit, potatoes, carrots, parsnips, beetroots, tomatoes, salad crops, unusual vegetables and eggs. Hydrangeas, sweet peas, roses, garden flowers and herbs
